The Mary S. Eidson Memorial Scholarship was established at the 1967 Convention of Louisiana State Chapter of the P.E.O. Sisterhood in memory of Mary S. Eidson. She was the first state president of the Louisiana State Chapter in 1946. This scholarship was designated to honor all past presidents of the Louisiana State Chapter. This fund, consisting of memorials and gifts, is used by the Louisiana State Chapter to donate to the P.E.O. International Peace Scholarship.

The fund is administered by the Louisiana State Board. With the approval of the Executive Board, and when funds are available, designated scholarships are sent from the Mary S. Eidson Memorial Scholarship Fund to the International Peace Scholarship Fund.

The fund is maintained through gifts of individuals and local chapters. Individuals who wish to donate to the fund should donate through their local chapter treasurer. Gifts are to be sent to the Louisiana State Chapter treasurer.
